Water conservation efforts such as low-flow faucets and toilets, are implemented.		
Energy efficiency efforts, such as LED lighting and Energy Star appliances, are in place.

## DEFINITIONS

**“Authorized Representative:”** Shall mean an individual with legal authority to execute this agreement, which binds the conduct of the representative restaurant. This is typically the owner or a manager.

**“Proper recycling:”** Shall mean following any city, county and/or state mandated recycling and food waste regulations and doing everything possible to recycle as many items as possible. If the restaurant or food truck sells beverages in cans or glass bottles, a separate container must be provided for their collection.

**“Water conservation efforts:”** Shall mean focusing on saving water in a drought, no hosing down outside to reduce urban runoff, and/or proper disposal of FOG (fats, oil and grease) to conserve water and help reduce sewage spills. Installing low-flow faucets and toilets is the easiest to verify.

**“Energy efficiency efforts:”** Shall mean using LED lights, installing solar panels, using Energy Star certified appliances and/or other efforts to use less energy.
